INTERCOMMUNITY, INC. AND ALCOHOL AND DRUG RECOVERY CENTERS, INC. (ADRC) TO UNITE TO EXPAND WHOLE PERSON HEALTH CARE SERVICES

Hartford, Feb 3, 2015- InterCommunity, Inc. and Alcohol and Drug Recovery Centers, Inc. (ADRC) have consummated a formal corporate affiliation, effective February 1, 2015. This comes after almost a year of the organizations working together to explore how to best work together to provide primary care, mental health, and addiction recovery services to those in need in Hartford, East Hartford, and the surrounding towns. Despite the decision not to merge the organizations, ADRC has assumed the name of InterCommunity Recovery Centers, Inc. (ICRC).

InterCommunity, Inc. and ADRC complement one another in mission and operations. While InterCommunity, Inc. operates a community health center and provides a wide array of behavioral health services, ADRC offers a similarly wide range of substance use treatment and recovery-supportive services.

“I am extremely excited about this opportunity to integrate mental health, addiction recovery and primary care services,” said Kimberly Beauregard, President and Chief Executive Officer of InterCommunity, Inc. and ICRC. “Our mission is to provide health care for the whole person, and this affiliation will help to meet the needs of our community.”

The combination will provide access to services across the spectrum of care, including primary care, residential detoxification and substance use treatment, multiple levels of residential care, outpatient substance use disorder and mental health services for adults and children, intensive outpatient programs, employment and community support, mobile crisis evaluations, judicial support services and social rehabilitation.

“ADRC clients will benefit so much from our new and integrated ways of providing access to many needed services – especially ongoing community-based mental health services and primary medical care,” said William Young, Chief Alliance and Integration Officer of InterCommunity, Inc. and ICRC and Vice President of the Addiction Recovery Division of InterCommunity, Inc. and ICRC. “ADRC has always emphasized these areas, and now thousands of those we serve will have those needs met through the coordinated care created by this affiliation.”

InterCommunity Inc. and ICRC will continue to operate their individual services and programs as before, in their respective locations. Administrative offices for both organizations will be located at 111 Founders Plaza 18th Floor, East Hartford, CT 06108.
